



Bingo House Rules

1. Patrons must be at least 21 years of age to participate.
2. Players may participate by purchasing at least one of the following:
 - a. Electronic bingo tablet.
 - b. Paper session package.
 - c. Only after purchasing a bingo tablet and/or paper session, will patrons become eligible to purchase additional special game packages (add-ons).
3. The winning bingo pattern(s) will be displayed and announced before each bingo round begins.
4. Players must possess receipt that matches what he or she is playing in order to claim winnings.
5. Players must bingo on the last number called to have a valid bingo.
 - a. A valid bingo is defined by completing the predetermined winning pattern.
 - b. "Sleepers" (not the last number called) will not be valid for any winning bingo.
6. It is the player's responsibility to yell, "Bingo!" loudly enough to get the caller's attention and stop the game.
 - a. If "Bingo!" is not yelled audibly enough, and the caller begins to call the next ball, the bingo will be declared invalid.
7. If there are multiple winners, the prize pool will be split as equally as possible amongst them.
8. Once the caller closes a game no other bingo will be honored.
9. No refunds or exchanges made for unused/not played paper specials or packages.
 - a. The Bingo Manager, or authorized designee, may grant refunds under extenuating circumstances at his or her discretion.

10. The following are prohibited from bingo:

- a. Drugs;
- b. Smoking;
- c. Food/drink from outside Clearwater Casino;
- d. Splitting of bingo packs; and
- e. Leaving the gaming facility with a bingo tablet.

11. All complaints or disputes will be directed to the Bingo Manager, or designee, whose decision is final.

Disclaimers

1. Anyone being disruptive to the game or other players will be asked to leave.
2. Management reserves the right to refuse service.
3. Clearwater Casino is not responsible for lost or stolen cards and/or tablets.
4. Odds of winning dependent upon the number of eligible bingo participants.
5. Any computer malfunction voids all pays and plays.
6. Winners may be asked to provide valid photo identification and Social Security number to claim their prize as applicable with IRS regulations.
 - a. Prizes are non-transferrable.
 - b. Winners are responsible for any applicable taxes.
7. By participating in bingo, you agree to have your name, photo, and/or likeness to be used in any future publicity materials published by the Clearwater Casino.
8. PME employees may participate in playing bingo in accordance with *Employee Handbook's Gaming Policy*.
9. The Clearwater Casino reserves the right to cancel and/or change bingo operations at any time without prior notification.
